Did you know that according to the Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention more than 1,000 Lyme disease cases have been reported annually in Maine since 2011 -- five times the number reported a decade ago? In 2013, Maine set a record with 1,376 cases of the bacterial infection, which is spread in the Northeast by deer tick bites. Come learn more about the various ticks found throughout Maine’s wooded areas and the health issues they may present. Discover ways to avoid exposure and what to look for if you are exposed.
